

Camp Co-op will offer **lots of fun** this summer.

Children ages 3 through 8 years may attend two or four days per week for one, two, three or four sessions.

The teachers plan many hands-on activities in art, nature, cooking, music, drama, and literature which can be explored at varying levels by children at different stages of development.

Each session has a theme, but there is always time for lots of free play, for reading a book in the shade, or for examining an interesting plant on our wonderful playground.

Camp Co-op provides an exceptional experience for young children and offers a unique program that nurtures parents as well. The foundation of our program is direct parent involvement. In addition to a qualified teacher, and a teacher's aide, two or three parents assist at camp each day on a rotating schedule. This provides an excellent adult/child ratio of 1:5 maximum.

Camp Co-op is operated by Fayette Cooperating Nursery School and Kindergarten which was established in 1951. It is a non-profit, non-discriminatory, independent educational institution, licensed by Kentucky's Cabinet for Health and Family Services.
